- A proven track record of research in hypertensive conditions of pregnancy
- Research and clinical experience mentoring beginning investigators
- General knowledge and experience with research and conditions of clinical care in low resource settings.
- Capacity to commit significant time and effort to the project without direct funding.
- Capacity to periodically visit the research site at least once or twice in two years. Note:
 EMPOWER program funding will cover travel expenses associated with 1-2 site visits over the course of the two-year grant.
- Regular (4-6 times per year) electronic contact (via video/tele-conferencing software provided by EMPOWER sponsors) to ensure site viability and the project's success.
